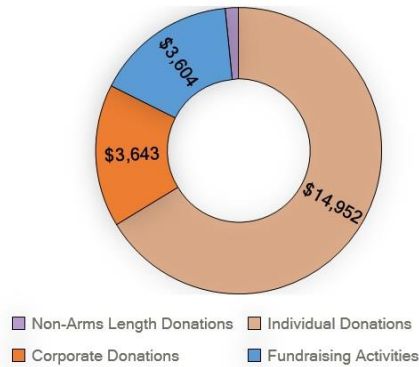
January 12-17, 2018

- “This has been one of the most meaningful experiences of my life.”



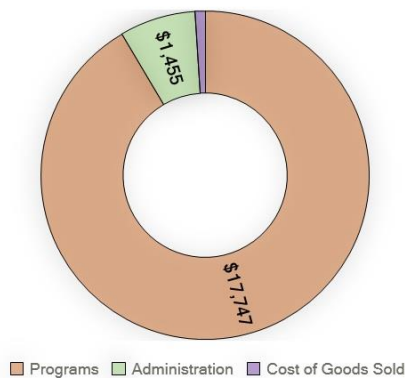
